Doctors In Training are fully qualified and have already done training in hospitals. You can expect them to provide a full range of GP services. If they are not certain about what to do they will ask more senior colleagues for advice. Thank you.



The NHS Health Check is a free check-up of your overall health. It can tell you whether you're at higher risk of getting certain health problems, such as heart disease, diabetes, kidney disease and stroke.

During the check-up you'll discuss how to reduce your risk of these conditions. If you're aged over 65, you'll also be told about symptoms of dementia to look out for.

Who is the NHS Health Check for?

If you're aged 40 to 74 and do not have a pre-existing health condition you should be invited to an NHS Health Check by your GP.

What happens at an NHS Health Check?

Your NHS Health Check will be done by a healthcare professional. The check takes about 20 to 30 minutes and usually includes measuring your height and weight, measuring your waist, a blood pressure test, a cholesterol test, and possibly a blood sugar level test. You may be asked to have a blood test at or before the NHS Health Check. You'll also be asked some questions about your health.



Your NHS Health Check results

At the end of your NHS Health Check, you'll have the chance to discuss your results and how to improve your scores, including where you can get support.

This could include talking about how to improve your diet, increase the amount of exercise you do, lose weight, stop smoking, reduce the amount of salt in your diet, reduce your alcohol intake and reduce your cholesterol.

You may also be referred to local services, such as stop smoking and physical activity services, to help you make any changes.
