We would like to inform you about upcoming national changes to the availability of Mounjaro (Tirzepatide).

Under the new guidance,

access to Mounjaro will be extremely limited and restricted to a small number of patients who meet specific eligibility criteria.

- Eligibility criteria for Mounjaro are strict and nationally defined.
- We kindly ask that you do not book an appointment or contact the practice to request Mounjaro. We are not permitted to prescribe it outside the approved criteria.



The partnership is designed for people who may prefer to seek support via text message and provides immediate and anonymous support for those who are waiting for further help.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING CERVICAL SCREENING

As of 1st July, the cervical screening interval will increase from 3 to 5 year recalls for those patients 24-49 years old, with a previous HPV negative result. Those patients who have had a cervical screening test within the last 3 years will be recalled as usual (3 years) and then from the next negative result, will be transferred to the 5-year recall.

The change is backed by better HPV testing technology and scientific evidence which shows that patients who have tested negative for HPV are extremely unlikely to go on to develop cervical cancer within the next 10 years. The change brings England into line with Scotland and Wales who have already introduced this change.

If during the recall period, you feel something is not right, please seek medical advice from your GP.
