- 4. If you have nominated a pharmacy already, you may see a page asking you to confirm the pharmacy your prescriptions are sent to.
- On the 'Select medication' page, select the checkbox for the medications you require, then select 'Continue'. You may be asked to enter more information about your request.
- You should see a confirmation page of the medications you have asked for. Check the details, then select 'Confirm and order prescription'.



If you are having difficulty with navigating online services, please speak to Reception.

Alternatively, you can come to the surgery and fill in a prescription slip.

Prescription medicines are strictly controlled for a reason – taking them without advice from a doctor or pharmacist can be very dangerous.

- Medicines might be expired, diluted, or something completely different.
- ⇒ They can cause harmful side effects or react badly with other medicines.
- ⇒ Some fake medications can even be fatal.

Always talk to your GP or pharmacist first. They'll help you understand what you're taking and how to take it safely.
